<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Grammar Focus</u></p> <p>Pupils will learn to apply phonic knowledge to reading and writing. When writing they will focus on punctuating their sentences and forming clear letters. They will also begin to retell stories and understand the core parts of a story including settings and characters.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Weather Experts: Cold, Cold, Cold!</u></p> <p>Pupils will begin to understand the effects of climate change and consider how we can combat these changes in our classroom. They will learn about the world's 7 continents focusing on Antarctica using compass directions and basic map skills.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Animals including humans</u></p> <p>Pupils will ask simple questions about the human body then gather and record data making observations and noticing patterns. They will identify, name, draw and label basic parts of the human body and say which body is associated with which sense.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Creation</u></p> <p>Pupils will learn and retell the creation story in Genesis. They will talk about their feelings and experiences about what is important to them in the world. Pupils will also ask questions and talk about their responsibility of looking after the world.</p>	<p>Pupils will learn number and place value and count up to 20 with a concrete representation of each number. They will also learn to form clear digits when writing.</p> <p>They will estimate and order numbers, counting on and back. They will learn to double numbers and find one more and one less. They will learn number bonds up to 10 and continue addition and subtraction. They will learn to recognise, name and describe shapes.</p> <p>They will use these skills and apply it to reason and problem solve.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Dance</u></p> <p>Pupils will master basic movements developing balance, agility and coordination through sequences.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Games</u></p> <p>Pupils will also develop these skills through tennis and participate in team games developing simple tactics.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Exploring Sounds: Weather</u></p> <p>Pupils will use sounds using their voices, movements and instruments to explore different ways music can be made to describe the weather.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>We are treasure hunters</u></p> <p>Pupils will learn about algorithms and use them to program a toy and follow instructions to hunt for treasure. They will also learn to spot a mistake in an algorithm and debug it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Self Portraits</u></p> <p>Pupils will compare famous self-portraits from a variety of different artists. They will develop the skills of observation and recording through drawing in a variety of media. Pupils will experiment with different techniques to create their own self portrait.</p>
