They will learn how to group objects distinguishing them from its material and also understanding the properties of materials and its purpose in building. They will be applying this knowledge to our new school building.</p>	<p><u>Christianity – Miracles and Stories about Jesus</u></p> <p>Pupils will learn about the Miracles of and other stories about Jesus' life. This is a time for them to ask questions, retell, reflect and relate stories back to their own personal experiences.</p>	<p>Pupils have developed their Maths meeting adding times tables into it to kick start every lesson and this will continue to add to it this term.</p> <p>They will continue to consolidate and master their number facts and bonds to apply them to solving mental addition and subtraction.</p> <p>The pupils this term will begin to apply their number facts when adding by putting the larger, 2-digit number first and counting on with the 1-digit.</p>
