- Provide an email, a letter of explanation or telephone call if child is absent
- Support and uphold the school's practices and guidelines for behaviour
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about your child's progress
- Support your child to complete and return homework at the right time
- Respect the safety of all children, staff and visitors by supporting the school's travel policy
