

Guidance for Parents re the extended opening of the school

Key Workers' children

The school will reopen to additional children on **Monday 15th June**. This means there will be some differences in the organisation of the day.

The school has carried out a risk assessment using documentation provided by the H&S at LBE. The following information is based on this and guidance from the DfE.

To allow the school to follow the guidance re “social bubbles” and minimising contact, please observe the following:

- The school day for Key Workers' children will start at **9am** and finish at **3pm** as before
- **Please note that the school will only be open Monday to Thursday from the 15th June**
- Only 1 adult should accompany the children onto the premises.
- Children should arrive and enter the premises by the gate adjacent to the cycle racks
- They will follow the usual path to their designated classroom unaccompanied by parents.
- There will be no need to “sign your child in” as we will be taking the register in the usual way
- Parents are then asked to leave the school site by the gate adjacent to the carpark.
- In the first instance, until the new routines are established, we would ask that children do not bring their scooters/bicycles to school
- At the end of the day, please access the school grounds via the carpark gate and wait along the front of the building in a “socially distanced” manner
- The children will be brought to the internal gate by staff and you will be called forward to collect your child.
- Please leave by the gate adjacent to the cycle racks
- The class will be supervised by the same members of staff each day
- There will be dedicated equipment for use by this group of children
- No school equipment or books will be sent home at this time
- Children will play outside separately away from other groups of children
- Children will eat lunch as a social bubble, seated at either end of a table
- There will always be an additional first aider present out with the classroom
- The staff have the appropriate advice and equipment to deal with suspected cases of COVID-19
- If you need to contact the staff with your child, please call or email the office and we will reply when able
- If you need to contact the office, please call or email
- At this time, parents will only be able to access the school building by appointment
- Given the narrow width of the pavement outside of the school, please do not linger by either gate as we seek to promote social distancing
- Children can continue to come to school in casual clothes as before
